## LOCATIONS

**Alameda Hospital** is a 251-bed community-based hospital with 70 acute care and 181 skilled nursing and subacute beds including medical, surgical, and intensive care. Locations include Waters Edge, and South Shore skilled nursing facilities, Creedon Advanced Wound Care, and Bay Area Bone and Joint, which offer several treatment specialties. Its 24-hour emergency room serves an estimated 17,000 patients a year and is a Certified Advanced Primary Stroke Center. [AlamedaAHS.org](http://AlamedaAHS.org)

**Fairmont Hospital** provides acute rehabilitation and skilled nursing services with 159 patient beds, including 109 skilled nursing beds and a 50-bed acute rehabilitation unit. Its experienced physicians and specialists provide care to patients who have suffered from multiple traumas, brain injury, stroke and other injuries, and illnesses that require rehabilitation and longer-term care. The Highland Care Pavilion provides same-day, primary and specialized health care in 10 specialty centers. The Acute Care Tower houses a family birthing center, NICU, DISC, technologically advanced laboratory, as well as predominantly private rooms with stunning views of Oakland.
