## SERVICES

Alameda Hospital offers comprehensive services, including cardiology, on-site 24-hour lab services, cancer care and infusion therapy, an advanced diagnostic imaging center, pulmonary and respiratory care, nutrition services, and occupational, speech and physical therapy. The hospital’s 24-hour, child-friendly Emergency Care Center has 12 board-certified emergency physicians and more than 35 registered nurses.

Alameda Hospital’s surgical services continue to expand and include hand surgeries, general orthopedics, sports medicine, gynecology and ophthalmology. The hospital’s specialty treatment centers include the Creedon Advanced Wound Care and Bay Area Bone and Joint Center. Additionally, the long-term care facilities at Alameda Hospital offer personalized programs to meet every need in skilled nursing care, rehabilitative care and sub acute care. Inpatient care services include critical care, medical/surgical care and telemetry.

The hospital’s highly skilled physicians provide comprehensive primary and specialty care, including cardiology, vascular surgery, allergy and immunology, anesthesiology, ear nose and throat (ENT), dermatology and gastroenterology. Other services include infectious disease medicine, nephrology and neurology. Gynecology, pain management, and plastic and reconstructive surgery are among the hospital’s offerings, along with podiatry and sports medicine.
