SERVICES

Fairmont's 50-bed inpatient Acute Rehabilitation Center offers comprehensive rehabilitation services with an experienced and highly professional staff. Patients are discharged once they are medically stable, with outpatient rehabilitation continuing as needed.

Fairmont's Rehabilitation Hospital treats most of the traumatic brain injuries in Alameda County. Many patients have suffered injuries from automobile or industrial accidents, falls, or assaults.

Outpatient services include physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech pathology and audiology. Outpatient clinics also offer services in general rehabilitation, prosthetics, orthotics, and EMG (electromyography). Ergonomic evaluations are also available.

Caregiver teams include physiatrists (physicians specializing in physical medicine and rehabilitation), certified rehabilitation registered nurses, physical therapists, occupational therapists, speech pathologists, neuro psychologists, audiologists, respiratory therapists, social workers and dietitians.
