## SERVICES

The brand new Acute Care Tower (ACT) houses inpatient services, a family birthing center, a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), a state-of-the-art Diagnostic Imaging Services Center (DISC), physical/occupational/speech therapy suites, a technologically advanced laboratory, as well as predominantly private rooms with stunning views of Oakland. The hospital's Highland Care Pavilion (HCP) provides same-day, primary and specialized health care in 10 specialty centers.

Other services include (but are not limited to): behavioral health, cancer care and infusion therapy, cardiology, dentistry, dermatology, emergency and trauma services, endoscopy, gastroenterology, hematology, HIV services, immunology, infectious disease services, kidney care, maternal child health, neurology, oncology, optometry, orthopedics, palliative care, pediatrics, radiology, respiratory care, and surgery.
