ABOUT US

San Leandro Hospital, located in San Leandro, California, is a community-based hospital providing inpatient and outpatient services, including surgical and intensive care, 24-hour emergency services, and a range of ancillary services including imaging, laboratory testing, and rehabilitation therapy.

The hospital was founded in 1960 by a group of community physicians. For more than 50 years, physicians, staff and volunteers at San Leandro Hospital have worked together to provide outstanding health care services to a community that they cherish.

As a leader within the community, San Leandro Hospital prides itself on hosting educational seminars, health fairs and additional care programs that are beneficial to its patients, with special consideration for seniors. The San Leandro Hospital Volunteer Auxiliary, comprised of 40 dedicated volunteers, has donated more than half a million hours of health care service since its inception in 1972.

As a member of the Alameda Health System, San Leandro Hospital has a direct connection to a nationally known institution of medical and educational excellence and its expanded health care services.

SERVICES

San Leandro Hospital offers a wide range of medical services, including 24-hour emergency services, critical care, and highly skilled surgery and rehabilitation services.

Specialized hospital programs include cardiology, infectious disease services, kidney and respiratory care, lab work, imaging services and social work.

The hospital's Computed Tomography (CT) Department is accredited by the American College of Radiology, a distinction marked by the highest level of care and diagnosis. Accreditation means the hospital's CT services meet or exceed national standards, and all providers have all attained high levels of education and/or certification.

San Leandro Hospital's rehabilitation services include occupational therapy, physical therapy, pulmonary rehabilitation, speech therapy and therapeutic swimming and aquatic exercise.

The hospital provides surgical services for patients referred through primary care physicians or clinics, including vascular and endovascular procedures, lithotripsy, dialysis access, laparoscopic procedures, orthopedics, ear nose and throat (ENT), podiatry, pacemaker insertion, oral surgery and dental procedures.

Through Alameda Health System, free interpretation services are offered in 28 languages.
