C. <u>REPORT/DISCUSSION: CLINICAL-OPERATIONAL RESPONSE TO COVID-19</u> Damon Francis, Medical Director Dr. Francis presented information on the clinical and operational response at AHS to COVID-19. Among other things, the presentation included an overview of AHS's response to COVID-19, including employee resources, delivery of information to employees, recommended steps to help reduce the spread of COVID-19, changes to access and visitation at AHS, information related to supplies and personal protective equipment (PPE), and triage and surge preparation. CAB Members asked several questions to clarify the information presented.

### D. MEDICAL DIRECTOR REPORT

Damon Francis, Medical Director

Dr. Francis provided a summary of AHS efforts, in partnership with Alameda County, to respond to COVID-19 for people experiencing homelessness. Dr. Francis described the risks for homeless shelters, congregate settings, encampments and large gatherings; and summarized the coordinated response goals to meet evolving needs. He also described major areas of activity and support provided by AHS and Alameda County. CAB Members asked several questions to clarify the information presented.

Heather provided a verbal summary of the Project Report, which included an update on health center compliance, Mobile Health Clinic, quality, and leadership and advocacy.
