C. <u>REPORT/DISCUSSION: Medical Director Report</u>

Damon Francis MD, Medical Director

Dr. Francis provided an update on COVID-19 for people experiencing homelessness and the governance transition of Alameda Health System. CAB members asked questions related to COVID-19 for people experiencing homelessness and the Health Management Associates recommendations for the governance structure for Alameda Health System.

D. REPORT/DISCUSSION: Complex Care Management/Care Transitions

Lilly MacRae RN, PHN, Manager, Outpatient Care Coordination

Lilly, Diondre Henderson, and Isha Jethi provided a presentation on the Complex Care Management and the Care Transitions program. The presentation included the background, funding, missions, goals, results, future program, and the future for the Complex Care Management and Care Transitions program. CAB members asked questions about how the programs matches patients to housing resources, how the program is funded and how the Homeless Health Center can support the program during the strategic planning process.

E. ACTION/DISCUSSION: Strategic Planning

Damon Francis MD, Medical Director and Wanda Johnson DNP, MSN, PHN, FNP-BC

DISCUSSION: Damon reviewed the Strategic Planning timeline. Damon outlined the limits and expectations of the retreat planning task force.

Wanda provided the Alameda Health System Homeless Health Center Needs Assessment. The presentation included an assessment of the physical, behavioral health and dental health needs for people experiencing homelessness. CAB member Smith asked questions about the impact of homelessness on people's life expectancy. CAB members discussed the impact of homelessness on people's lives.

Damon presented an updated SWOT Analysis. He provided a summary of strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats. CAB members discussed participation in advocacy efforts for patients and for consumer governance at Alameda Health System.
