A. BOARD CHAIR REPORT

Loretta Medellin, Chair

Dr. Francis provided an overview of supplemental funding available to the Homeless Health Center and the guiding principles with which AHS Homeless Health Center is considering for proposal consistent with the guiding principles made previously by the CAB. The CAB asked questions and provided ideas for consideration in the development of the proposals for supplemental funding.
