We appreciate your patience as we continue our work to improve the HVAC system at Alameda Hospital. This important project reflects our continued commitment to providing critical health care services at Alameda Hospital by ensuring a safe, modern, and comfortable environment for our patients, staff, and community. Planning, preparation, and construction have been ongoing, and we wanted to provide you with an update on what to expect in the coming weeks.

In April, there will be some outdoor construction activity beginning with the staging of equipment. The week of April 14, work on the exterior of the hospital is expected to begin. We understand that noise is a concern, and we are pleased to share that the construction company has agreed to use quieter devices to lessen the impact, with some materials being prefabricated in their off-site location in Concord. The noise level is not expected to be any louder than typical residential remodeling.
